1 Samuel 1:21–28

²¹The man Elkanah and all his house went up to offer to the LORD the yearly sacrifice and to pay his vow. ²²But Hannah did not go up, for she said to her husband, "As soon as the child is weaned, I will bring him, so that he may appear in the presence of the LORD and dwell there forever." ²³Elkanah her husband said to her, "Do what seems best to you; wait until you have weaned him; only, may the LORD establish his word." So the woman remained and nursed her son until she weaned him. ²⁴And when she had weaned him, she took him up with her, along with a three-year-old bull, an ephah of flour, and a skin of wine, and she brought him to the house of the LORD at Shiloh. And the child was young. ²⁵Then they slaughtered the bull, and they brought the child to Eli. ²⁶And she said, "Oh, my lord! As you live, my lord, I am the woman who was standing here in your presence, praying to the LORD. ²⁷For this child I prayed, and the LORD has granted me my petition that I made to him. ²⁸Therefore I have lent him to the LORD. As long as he lives, he is lent to the LORD."



P The Holy Gospel according to St. Luke, the second chapter.




²²When the time came for their purification according to the Law of Moses, [Mary and Joseph] brought [Jesus] up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord ²³(as it is written in the Law of the Lord, "Every male who first opens the womb shall be called holy to the Lord") ²⁴and to offer a sacrifice according to what is said in the Law of the Lord, "a pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons." ²⁵Now there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon, and this man was righteous and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. ²⁶And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ. ²⁷And he came in the Spirit into the temple, and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him according to the custom of the Law, ²⁸he took him up in his arms and blessed God and said,

- ²⁹"Lord, now you are letting your servant depart in peace, according to your word;
- ³⁰for my eyes have seen your salvation ³¹that you have prepared in the presence of all peoples,
- ³²a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to your people Israel."

TITLE OF THE SERMON:

"CHRIST JESUS, THE FULFILLMENT, LIGHT, AND GLORY"

TEXT: Luke 2:22-32 DATE: 2-2-25

LITURGICAL DAY: The Purification of Mary and the Presentation of Our Lord Theme: Jesus is the fulfillment of the Law and thus our Light and our very Glory.

II. THE CHRIST, A LIGHT TO THE GENTILES

CONCLUSION:

The Christ subjected Himself to the Law even as a babe, in order that he might redeem us from the Law's curse. He submitted, with His holy mother, to the purification and presentation ascribed to every firstborn according to the Law. From His very first days, He lived and was subjected to the severity of the Law. Simeon, filled with the Holy Spirit, was able to see this babe, not as a beggarly child, born of poor parents, but for what He was – the light to all people and the very glory of God's people. Simeon after beholding the Light of the world and glory of his people, with a heart filled with joy, sees no death, and cannot even call it death but rather a peaceful journey. He does not say "now I wish to die," but rather "now I wish to depart in peace." And such an end it is for all who cling to this babe, this Light and Glory.






The Words of Our Lord



Amen.


Take, drink; this is the true blood of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, shed for the forgiveness of your sins.




