



**Epistle** Romans 5:1–11

<sup>1</sup>Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>2</sup>Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God. <sup>3</sup>More than that, we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, <sup>4</sup>and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, <sup>5</sup>and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

## "WHAT ARE THE THINGS OF GOD?"

TEXT: Mark 8:27-38 DATE: 2-25-24 LITURGICAL DAY: 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Lent *Theme: What are the things of God?* 

#### I. TO CONFESS JESUS AS THE CHRIST

-confess the creeds along with the apostles

#### II. TO BE TAUGHT BY THE SON OF MAN

-hearing and reading the word of the cross preached and taught

#### III. TO DENY YOURSELF, TAKE UP YOUR CROSS, FOLLOW HIM

-dying to our old Adam in baptism
- receiving His divine gifts in absolution and holy communion
-speaking the Gospel of Jesus to others in your daily vocation

<u>CONCLUSION:</u> The Son of Man suffered many things, was rejected, killed and on the third day rose again. These are the things of God in the Gospel. We save our lives by losing them for Jesus Christ and we are not ashamed to proclaim His Word in the midst of our adulterous and sinful generation. When the Son of Man returns in the Father's glory with all the holy angels, He will not be ashamed of us and will save us unto eternal life!




Take, drink; this is the true blood of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, shed for the forgiveness of your sins.






