Sermon

Theme: Only because the Good Shepherd lays down His life may the flock know Him.

- I. A WOLF PROWLS AFTER THE SHEEP TO SNATCH THEM FROM THE SHEPHERD AND SCATTER THEM.
- II. BUT THE SHEPHERD SACRIFICES HIMSELF IN PLACE OF THE SHEEP.
- III. BY THIS WE THE SHEEP KNOW OUR SHEPHERD AND WE KNOW THAT HE KNOWS US.

CONCLUSION: The Good Shepherd knows His flock and the flock follows the Shepherd in deed and in truth.
