





#### **Nicene Creed**


THEME: The Christian's Identity in Christ

I. The order of the world is broken. II. The Beatitudes are about Christ III. The Christian receives their identity in Christ.

CONCLUSION: Jesus ascended the mountain to speak the Gospel to His people. On that mountain, He spoke of the day when all things would be made new, and then He climbed up another mountain, covered in the stripes of our sin and carrying the weight of our iniquity. On that mountain, He established a new order and gave the Christian the promise of eternal life. Jesus became poor and meek so that we could find our identity in Him. As God's son, he shared His identity with us so that we could live with Him for all eternity and never hunger or thirst anymore. We will stand before Our Lord, and He will lead us to streams of life-giving water, and our desire for righteousness will be satisfied.






