⁹"Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.



"WASHED IN THE BLOOD OF THE LAMB"

TEXT: Revelation 7:9-17, 1 John 3:1-3, Mark 5:1-12 DATE: 11-7-21 LITURGICAL DAY: All Saints' Day

THEME: We are washed clean in the blood of Jesus.

I. Through sin, death has entered the world.

II. God has made us his children, so that we are not lost to death.

III. Our sins and the sins of ones who have passed through tribulation are washed away in the blood of Jesus.





In dismissing the communicants, the following is said:


