
**Holy Gospel** *Mark* 11:1–10

P The Holy Gospel according to St. Mark, the eleventh chapter.



<sup>1</sup>When they drew near to Jerusalem, to Bethphage and Bethany, at the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two of his disciples <sup>2</sup>and said to them, "Go into the village in front of you, and immediately as you enter it you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever sat. who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified, who spoke by the prophets.



12-3-23 TEXT: Mark 11:1-10 LITURGICAL DAY: Advent Sunday

Theme: Christ shows us God's majesty as He humbly takes on our flesh.

- I. GOD'S WORD PRECEDES HIM AND IT DOES NOT RETURN VOID.
- II. THE WORD OF GOD MADE FLESH ENTERS JERUSALEM AS A KING ON A COLT.
- III. THOSE WHO WENT BEFORE AND THOSE WHO FOLLOW CRY OUT "HOSANNA!"
