





Sermon

12-24-23 TEXT: Luke 1:26-38

Theme: The mystery that was kept secret for long ages has now been disclosed in the womb of a virgin.

I. THE ANGEL GABRIEL REVEALS THE GIFT TO MARY THAT THE PROPHETS LONG FORETOLD.

II. THIS GIFT IN MARY'S WOMB COMES BEARING HOPE FOR US WHO HAVE NO HOPE BESIDE HIM.

III. SO WE NOW HAVE THE JOY OF OUR HOPE IN GOD'S WORD WHO COMES IN THE FLESH.

Amen.


