Abram Trusts YHWH (Again)

Genesis 13:1-18

Genesis 13:1-4 ¹So Abram went up from Egypt, he and his wife and all that he had, and Lot with him, into the Negeb. ²Now Abram was very heavy with livestock, with silver, and with gold. ³And he journeyed on from the Negeb as far as Bethel to the place where his tent had been at the beginning, between Bethel and Ai, ⁴to the place where he had made an altar at the first. And there Abram called upon the name of YHWH.

- 2 "Abram was very rich"- he was rich before tricking Pharaoh, now he's even wealthier!
- 3 "where his tent had been at the beginning"- 12:8
- 4 "there Abram called upon the name of YHWH"- keep track of how often this happens Luther translates it differently- "there Abram *preached* the name of the Lord,"

Genesis 13:5-7

Wealth, though a blessing, can certainly come between families.

7 Canaanites & Perizzites- enemies, reminds us of the danger in the land

Genesis 13:8-13

- 8-9 Abram is a man of peace, desiring harmony with his nephew. He gives Lot first choice
- "like the garden of YHWH"- a reference back to Eden
 "(This was before YHWH destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah.)"- chapter 19
- "Abram settled in the land of Canaan"- takes the lesser land, trusting God's promise 12:7
- 13 Sets up chapter 19 already, also a contrast between the cities of the valley and herd land

Genesis 13:14-18

God confirms His promise once again, and expands it! Compare 12:7 with 13:14-17- What is added?

"Abram moved his tent"- checking out the land
By the oaks of Mamre- "there he built an altar to YHWH"- in Shechem, in Bethel, & in Hebron

Genesis 14:1-10

In summary- The land of Ham is ripe for battles and warfare 4 lands/peoples- Shinar, Ellasar, Elam, Goiim

Versus 5- Sodom, Gomorrah, Admah, Zeboiim, Bela/Zoar Hamites 10:19

"bitumen pits"- either asphalt or tar due to the Salt Sea

Genesis 14:11- 16

- "Abram the Hebrew"- descendent of Eber 10:25, 11:14, name also has a double meaning
- "trained men...318"- he has a small militia all his own
- 15 A night attack using his force to attack from multiple sides, tactic employing confusion

Abram Blessed by The King of Righteousness

Genesis 14:17-24

- 17 "the King's Valley"- a later editorial insertion indicating this event took place near Jerusalem
- 18 "Melchizedek"- name means; "The King of Righteousness" or "My King Is Righteousness"
 - "King of Salem"- translates King of Peace. Salem as in JeruSALEM
- "brought out bread & wine"- essential to a celebratory meal, can the typology go any deeper?! "priest of God"- The typology just went deeper! This is before Levi is born and the Levites are designated "priests."
 - "God Most High"- El Elyon, (Ps 7:17; 9:2; 18:3; 46:4)
- 19 "And he blessed him"- Blessing someone is HUGE in Genesis. More on the blessing in a minute
- 20 "he gave him a tenth"- Hebrew text is ambiguous who gave to whom (Heb 7:2 clears it up)
- "lifted my hand to YHWH"- made an oath, interesting Abram uses the words of Melchizedek's blessing "God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth"
- 23-24 Abram trusts God's promise of prosperity and blessing, does not turn to the riches here NOW- About Melchizedek!
- First he appears out of nowhere
- Name means King of Righteousness/Justification
- His office is King of Salem/Peace which is most likely the territory of Jerusalem
- Brings to Abraham bread & wine
- Is called a Priest of God Most High- so he is king and priest! Remind you of anyone?
- Blesses Abram and God
- Receives a tithe from Abram
- Disappears

Psalm 110; Hebrews 5:1-10; 6:17-20; and HEBREWS 7!
