Why Study the Old Testament?

- St. Augustine- "The New Testament is hidden in the Old Testament, and the Old Testament is made clear in the New Testament"

Introduction to the Torah

Hebrew "Torah" means- Instruction

in Greek- "nomos" = Law

(Ps 1:1-2; 19:7)

Author and Compiler = Moses

(Mt 19:8; Mk 7:10, 12:26; Jn 7:19)

- Moses also used oral and written sources (cf. Luke 1:1-4)
 - + The Account of Adam (Gen 5:1)
 - + The Song of Miriam (Ex 15:20-21)
 - + Book of the Wars of the LORD (Num 21:14-15)
 - + The Song of the Well (Num 21:17-18)
 - + The Song of Heshbon (Num 21:27-30)
- Some copyists updated place names in the text (Gen 14:14, 36:31) Difficulty of Hebrew Narrative- Circulation!

Introduction to Genesis

Genesis is organized by ten statements, "These are the generations..."

Gen 2:4- "... of the Heavens and the Earth when they were created,"

Gen 5:1- "This is the Book of the Generations of Adam."

Gen 6:9- "... of Noah."

Gen 10:1- "... of the sons of Noah, Shem, Ham, and Japheth."

Gen 11:10- "... of Shem."

Gen 11:27- "... of Terah."

Gen 25:12- "... of Ishmael, Abraham's son,"

Gen 25:19- "... of Isaac, Abraham's son"

Gen 36:1 & 9- "... of Esau (that is, Edom)... the father of the Edomites."

Gen 37:2- "... of Jacob."
